

## Coverage End Dates Resulting from Federal Action

Date	Coverage Type	Population Impacted
<b>8/25/2025</b>	Health Connector	Members who are DACA recipients
<b>1/1/2026</b>	Health Connector	ConnectorCare members under 100% FPL (Plan Type 1) and over 400% (Plan Type 3D) are no longer eligible for premium subsidies
<b>7/1/2026</b>	Medicare	Eligibility for new applicants is limited to legal permanent residents, Cuban Haitian entrants, and COFA migrants only
<b>10/1/2026</b>	Medicaid/MassHealth	Only legal permanent residents, Haitian Cuban entrants, COFA migrants, pregnant women, and lawfully present kids will still get federally funded Medicaid. Refugees, aliens granted asylum, victims of trafficking, certain abused spouses and children will no longer qualify.
<b>1/1/2027</b>	Health Connector	Most lawfully present immigrants will no longer qualify for subsidies. Only legal permanent residents, Cuban Haitian entrants, or COFA migrants will be eligible
<b>2/1/2027</b>	Medicare	Current immigrant recipients will no longer be eligible in accordance with the new guidelines (only legal permanent residents, Cuban Haitian entrants, and COFA migrants qualify)
