Current Insurance Status	Actions Needed
<p>Temporary MassHealth members in the first wave (received purple notices)</p>	<p>In order to not have a gap in coverage, these members are required to submit a new application by January 15th.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If they apply by January 15th, their temporary MassHealth will be extended through January 31st. These applicants must still select a plan by January 23rd and make their premium payments (if any) by January 30th for February 1st coverage. • If they fail to apply by January 15th, don't select a plan by January 23rd, and make their premium payments (if any) by January 30th, then they will be uninsured as of January 15th.
<p>Current Commonwealth Care (received yellow notices), former MSP (received yellow notices), and temporary MassHealth members in the second wave (received blue notices)</p>	<p>In order to not have a gap in coverage, these members are required to submit a new application, select a plan by January 23rd, and make their premium payments (if any) by January 30th for February 1st coverage.</p> <p>If they fail to apply, and select a plan by January 23rd, and make their premium payment (if any) by January 30th, then they will be uninsured as of February 1st.</p>
<p>Temporary Small Business Employee Premium Assistance (SBEPA) members</p>	<p>These members received their last premium assistance check in December 2014 (for January 2015 premiums). They will no longer receive premium assistance starting February 1st.</p> <p>If these members would like to still receive help paying for coverage, they need to apply, select a plan, and pay their premiums (if any) by January 23rd for February 1st coverage.</p>
<p>Temporary MassHealth members in the third wave (received green notices)</p>	<p>In order to not have a gap in coverage, these members are required to submit a new application and select a plan by February 15th.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If they apply and select a plan by February 15th, their temporary MassHealth will be extended through February 28th. These applicants must still make their premium payments (if any) by February 23rd. • If they fail to apply and select a plan by February 15th, they will be uninsured as of February 15th. If they apply and select a plan by February 15th but do not make their premium payments (if any) by February 23rd, then they will be uninsured as of March 1st.
